A. Call to Order

The hearing of the Arizona State Liquor Board was called to order on July 27, 2012 at 11:01 a.m. with Mr. Ghelfi presiding.

This matter was before the Board to consider the motions to continue filed by public protestors. The agent, Nicholas Carl Guttilla, appeared (telephonically) at the hearing. Public protestors Mary Savchick and Betsy Stamatakos were also present (telephonically) at the hearing.

Chairman Ghelfi noted concerns with the motions as they do not specify which protestors can't attend the hearing. Ms. Savchick noted concerns traveling to Phoenix for the hearing including health issues. Ms. Stamatakos stated she is a long time resident of the area and shared the same concerns as Ms. Savchick due to age. Mr. Guttilla pointed out that motions to continue were not filed by the Applicant, the City or the Department. He stated that protestor availability with no evidence is not basis to continue the matter. He further stated that this application has been delayed since 2009 and his clients are ready to proceed. Mr. Guttilla requested that if the matter is continued that it be heard at the October Board meeting. Chairman Ghelfi stated that the Board would not debate the merit or validity of the protest letters today and that the basis for this meeting is to determine if the hearing will be held on August 2, 2012 or a future date. Ms. Savchick stated that a hearing in August would be hazardous to her health and she would not attend.

Mr. Linden made a motion to deny the motions to continue based on some of the motions being filed on behalf of other people and some of the protestors who filed motions will be able to attend the hearing on August 2, 2012. The hearing will proceed as scheduled on August 2, 2012 on the 1:00 pm. agenda.
