A meeting was called to consideration the motion for rehearing filed by protestor Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District ("SRP"). This license was granted at the September 6, 2012 Board meeting and was originally set for hearing because the City of Phoenix recommended disapproval of the application and due to public protest. The applicant's Agent, Blair Cordon Driggs, and the applicant, Cory James Anderson, appeared at the hearing and was represented by counsel, Peter Schelstraete. Vojtek "VK" Karpuk appeared (telephonically) at the hearing and represented SRP. Assistant City Prosecutor Esteban J. Gomez, Deputy City Clerk Elizabeth Parker and License Services Supervisor Denise Archibald were also present (telephonically) on behalf of the City of Phoenix.

Mr. Karpuk and Mr. Schelstraete made opening statements. Mr. Schelstraete noted new material evidence presented and described the city verbatim and motion making the SPR protest letter part of the record which was a violation of Title 4. He also cited irregularity at the hearing
