

Two unique opportunities for bar (series 6) and beer and wine bar (series 7) licensees will expire in 5 short weeks. The two opportunities are:

- 1) Without application, the surrender of an issued and active bar (series 6) in **exchange** for a liquor store (series 9) license at no additional charge (renewal fees will apply; and
- 2) With application and qualification, in **addition** to an issued and active beer and wine bar (series 7), the licensee may be issued a beer and wine store (series 10) license at no additional charge.

For your convenience, Session Law reference for each transaction are included below.

**Section 20, Laws 2010, Chapter 85, section 4(A) – 6 for 9; license exchange**

Description: This law extends the exchange of a bar (series 6) for a liquor store (series 9) license. Until January 1, 2012, the owner of an issued and actively used bar (series 6) licensees may surrender the license used primarily for off-premise sales, and in exchange be immediately issued a liquor store (series 9) license at no cost, without application, and without further approval from DLLC. DLLC will render the bar (series 6) license void and extinguished. The renewal fees for the liquor store (series 9) license will apply.

**Section 20, Laws 2010, Chapter 85, section 4(C) – 7 and 10; license addition**

Description: Until January 1, 2012, this provision allows beer and wine bar (series 7) licensees to apply for a beer and wine store (series 10) license and, if licensee meets qualifications, for DLLC to immediately issue, at no cost, a beer and wine store (series 10) license. The beer and wine bar (series 7) and the beer and wine store (series 10) may be "stacked" or in active status simultaneously at the same location. If sampling privileges (10S) are desired, an application must be submitted and new "S" fees apply after August 1, 2011.
