Entry Forms and Applications

Entry Forms/Applications will be accepted from 8:00 a.m. on Monday, April 21, 2014 through 3:00 p.m. on Friday, May 16, 2014. A Random Selection Drawing will be held on Monday, June 2, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. at 800 West Washington, Phoenix, AZ 85007, in the 1st Floor Auditorium.

There are two different types of lottery entry forms:

- 1) Disclosed Location Entry Form – for applicants that have selected a business location
- 2) Non-disclosed Location Entry Form – for applicants that have not selected a business location

Disclosed Location Fees

A non-refundable deposit of 50 percent (50%) of the Fair Market Value (FMV) of the license is due by Monday, September 15, 2014 (105 days after the date that the random selection drawing was held) with the balance of the FMV due within 5 days after notification that the license is ready for issuance. Failure to submit required fees will result in disqualification and an alternate applicant will be chosen. Only certified funds will be accepted. No credit cards.

Non-disclosed Location Fees: A non-refundable deposit of 50 percent (50%) of the Fair Market Value (FMV) of the license is due by Monday, September 15, 2014 (105 days after the date that the random selection drawing was held). The balance of the FMV due within five days after notification that the license is ready for issuance or no later than Monday, March 16, 2015 (180 days after initial 50% deposit due date), whichever date occurs first. Failure to submit required fees will result in disqualification and an alternate applicant will be chosen. Only certified funds will be accepted. No credit cards.

Disclosed Location Random Selection Criteria

- a. Each applicant will be required to meet the qualifications of licensure before being issued the license. *A.R.S. §4-202 and 203*
- b. To meet license issuance requirements, the liquor license applicant must establish a physical address for the business. *A.R.S. §4-203*
- c. No person shall submit more applications than the number of licenses available for each series in a county.
- d. No person shall submit more than one entry form per location per liquor license series.
- e. If the number of applicants for entry into the drawing do not exceed the number of licenses in a series to be issued in that county, without using the random selection process the department shall issue a number of licenses equal to the number of entries received.
- f. An independent accounting firm will assign an ID number to each entry. These numbers will be mailed to applicants by the firm prior to the date of the random selection.
- g. Alternate applicants will be drawn for each license series in each county if applicable. An alternate list of applicants will be maintained until all new licenses have been issued.
- h. Alternates shall be eligible for consideration as licensees in the event that a successful applicant chooses not to be considered or is disqualified. Such consideration shall be determined by the numerical order in which the alternates were drawn.

Non-disclosed Location Random Selection Criteria

- a. Each applicant will be required to meet the qualifications of licensure before the license will be activated. *A.R.S. §4-202 and 203*
- b. By Friday, June 2, 2017 (36 months after the date the random selection drawing was held) non-disclosed location applicants must establish a physical address for the business.
- c. No person shall submit more applications than the number of licenses available for each series in a county.
- d. The rights to the license cannot be sold or transferred at any time between Monday, September 15, 2014 and Friday, June 2, 2017.
- e. If the number of applicants for entry into the drawing do not exceed the number of licenses in a series to be issued in that county, without using the random selection process the department shall issue a number of licenses equal to the number of entries received.
- f. The independent accounting firm will assign an ID number to each entry. These numbers will be mailed to applicants by the firm prior to the date of the random selection.
- g. Alternate applicants will be drawn for each license series in each county if applicable. An alternate list of applicants will be maintained until all new licenses have been issued.
- h. Alternates shall be eligible for consideration as licensees in the event a successful applicant chooses not to be considered or is disqualified. Such consideration shall be determined by the numerical order in which the alternates were drawn.
