

RESTAURANT CONTINUATION LICENSE OPTION SET TO EXPIRE

Pursuant to [A.R.S. §4-213\(E\)](#), the Department's authority to approve restaurant continuation licenses will expire on Sunday, June 30, 2013.

Please note that the continuation license is not a license renewal. To learn more, please read this link [A.R.S. §4-213\(E\)](#).

The sunset of the continuation license may impact Series 11 (hotel/motel w/restaurant) and series 12 (restaurant) as follows:

Series 11 (hotel/motel w/restaurant) and series 12 (restaurant) audits initiated on or after July 1, 2013 will not have access to the option of a restaurant continuation license.

Consent agreements, in which the licensee has not agreed in writing to the agreement terms, formally or informally, prior to July 1, 2013, will not have access to the option of a restaurant continuation license.

Series 11 (hotel/motel w/restaurant) and series 12 (restaurant) licensees who have provided the department with email addresses on their renewal application will be notified via email that this option will no longer be available in addition other helpful information will be provided. Notice will also be posted on the [Department of Liquor homepage](#) no later than March 29, 2013.
