<p>Shall produce more than five thousand (5,000) gallons of beer per calendar year following the first year of operation and shall not exceed one million two hundred forty thousand (1,240,000) gallons of beer production in a calendar year.</p>	<p>May sell beer produced on premises to Arizona-licensed wholesalers, and to Arizona-licensed retailers with the same ownership as the microbrewery.</p> <p>May sell beer produced on premises to Arizona-licensed retailers in an amount not to exceed ninety-three (93,000) gallons per year.</p> <p>May sell beer produced on premises to licensees in another state if lawful under the laws of that state. The amount shall not to exceed ninety-three (93,000) gallons per year.</p>	<p>May sell beer produced on premises for consumption on the site of the microbrewery or for carry-out.</p> <p>May hold other liquor licenses and sell liquor not produced on the property. Additional license may be on or adjacent to microbrewery.</p>	<p>May serve beer produced on premises for sampling.</p>	<p>ARS §4-205.08</p>
