In addition to any executive sessions listed below, when necessary, the Board or Panel may move to go into executive session intermittently throughout the meeting regarding any of the open meeting agenda items pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3) for discussion or consultation for legal advice with the attorney or attorneys of the public body or review any confidential records and/or A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(2), respectively. The Board may review, discuss or take action on any item on the agenda. Further, except for those matters indicating a specific time, the presiding officer will set the order of the agenda and items may be taken out of order.
